Raymond A. Quinlan, 88, of Decatur, died December 14, 1993 at Decatur Memorial Hospital. Services were held December 17 in Grace United Methodist Church, Decatur with burial in Monticello cemetery.

Mr. Quinlan was born in Piatt County, s/o Orville D. and Mamie Arnold Quinlan. He married Beatrice L. Dons in 1941. She died in 1974. He then married Cora B. Quinlan in 1976. She survives. Also surviving are a daughter, Donna Morgan of Winfield MO; step-son, Gary A. Quinlan of Decatur; two step-daughters: Barbara Meurlot, Decatur; and Carolyn Sue Jeffers, Springfield; eight grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a brother.

Mr. Quinlan was a longtime member of the First Presbyterian Church, Monticello; and was a present member of the Grace United Methodist Church of Decatur. He was a life member of IL Retired Teachers and Decatur Area Teachers organizations. He was past president and 50-year member of Monticello Rotary Club; associate member of Macon County Historical Society; member of Macon County Farm Bureau.
